## **Ugly Fabric Challenge**

There's still time to participate in the ugly fat quarter challenge, so just call Kay ([616-842-0921](tel:616-842-0921)). We can arrange a drop off. Everyone will be able to pick up their challenge fabric at the January meeting. If you can't be there, just call Kay to arrange a pick up. I can't wait to see the finished quilts in June!

*Rules are as follows:*

Size of quilt must be between 15 and 20 inches when finished.

Any technique or combination of techniques may be used.

Embellishments may be added but aren't necessary.

Quilt must be quilted either by hand or machine or a combination of both.

Fabric must be recognizable on the front of the quilt, not just the binding or borders.

Pin 2 to 2 1/2 inch square of the challenge fabric to the front of the finished quilt.

Deadline for the quilt is the June 2017 guild meeting.

## **Community Outreach**

*Habitat for Humanity.* We were excited to take a quilt to the dedication of the new Habitat for Humanity home on Wednesday, December 21st. It was the quilt donated by Beth Maschewske, a bright and lovely Bonnie Hunter pattern. Perfect for a single mom with a three children to cuddle under in time for Christmas.

A lot of our guild members have made blocks for our next quilt for Habitat for Humanity, but there is still enough background for the last 20. We will bring the fabric to our January meeting and hope to entice a few more members to help out. We will be assembling the quilt at the February sew-in.

*Baby Quilts:* We are introducing a new baby quilt kit for the January meeting. It is called "Criss-Cross" and has all the elements we like in the quilts -- lots of color, along with numbers, letters, animals, etc. It is also a pattern that allows us to use up small amounts of coordinating fabrics from our stash. We are making up a pile of kits and hope you will try one. It is quite easy and fast to put together. Here's a sneak peek:



*Save the Date:* There will be a Community Outreach Sew-In on Monday, February 13th. Come and sew for one of our charities -- or to finish a last-minute Valentine gift. Stay for the soup supper and then attend the guild meeting.

Quilting tips from Country Stitches Quilt Shop:

1. Quilting a quilt: Evenly cover the whole quilt – the unquilted area should not be larger than a clenched fist.
2. When marking quilting lines on a quilt top, you don't have to mark the entire line. You can use dots and dashes and your eye will fill in the rest.
3. If you are prewashing fabric, clip the corners. This will prevent fraying. In addition, you can easily tell which fabrics you have washed.
4. Test your 1/4" seam to make sure your blocks will match each other.
5. Be sure to set your stitch length at 2.0 in order to get secure stitches.
6. Cross grain of the fabric (from selvage to selvage) has some stretch. Lengthwise grain (parallel with the selvage) has very little stretch.

### **Weather Related Meeting Cancellations**

If Grand Haven Public Schools cancel school or evening school events, then there will be no meeting for the Lighthouse Quilt Guild.
