



HARLEQUIN BABY QUILT - 34" x 43"

Your kit contains:

- 80 bright-colored 5" squares
- 16 white 2½" squares
- 16 black 2½" squares
- 42" x 50" backing

Start by selecting 16 bright squares to receive the white corners. Place a 2½" white square on one corner of each bright square. Draw a diagonal line across the square and sew on that line. Finger-press the sewn square to one side, making sure it covers the corner of the bright square. See picture above.

Next, select another 16 bright squares for black corners and repeat the steps.

Cut away the underlying fabrics and press the squares. Next, make the Harlequin four-patches by sewing two white-corner and two black-corner blocks together. See the quilt illustration for the orientation of the corners. Make 8 Harlequin four-patches.

Make 8 four-patches from 32 of the bright squares. Make two rows of 8 squares.

Lay out the quilt as shown above.

Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt no wider than 5" apart. Sew on the label and bind, either by hand or machine.
