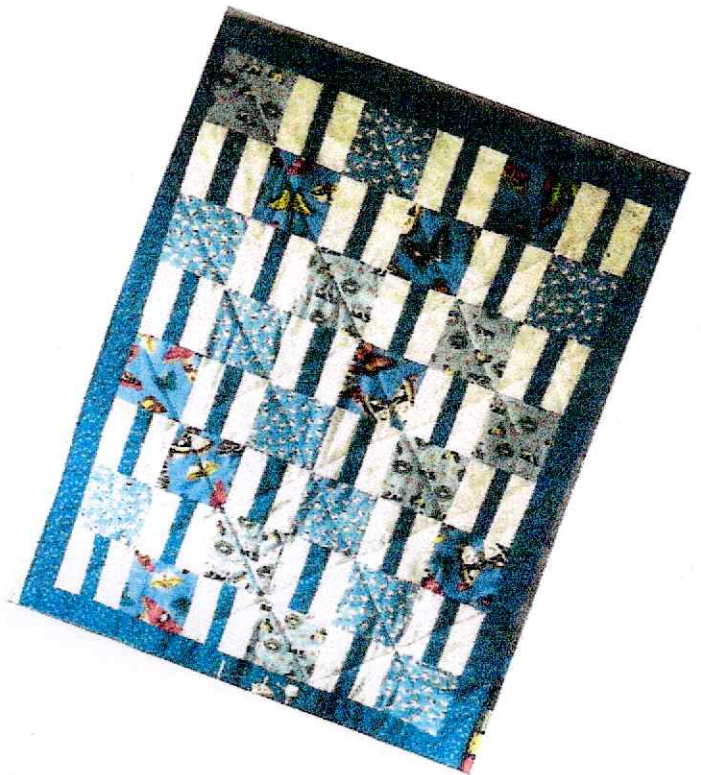


## **DOTTIE'S COLORFUL QUILT - 32"x42"**

This kit contains:

24 5" print squares

Materials for setting squares:

6 2¼" strips of neutral fabric

3 1½" strips of feature fabric

4 strips of feature fabric for borders

Backing fabric

Check your materials to verify you have what you need to make the quilt top.

Construct the 3 strip sets for making the 5" setting squares. Sew the strips of neutral fabric on each side of the 1½" feature fabric. Make sure the finished strip set is 5" wide. Press the seams to the dark side. Cut 24 setting blocks from the strip sets.

Lay out your quilt top as in the diagram, alternating print squares and setting blocks. The quilt will be 6 blocks wide and 8 blocks down. Sew the blocks together and then the rows. Press the quilt top. Add the borders to the long sides; then add borders to top and bottom.

Sandwich the quilt, using your preferred method. Quilt no less than 5" apart. Sew on the label.
