HIDDEN 9-PATCH BABY QUILT 38"x46"

The kit contains:


20 novelty 6" squares (all different)

20 plain 6" squares (usually a light solid)

5 6" bright-color squares

4 4½" border strips

Sew the blocks together in 9-patch fashion as in illustration, using the novelty squares on the 4 corners. You will have five blocks measuring 17" square

Cut for Re-Assembly

After the blocks are completed, cut each block across the center, both horizontally and vertically as shown in the second picture. You will now have a total of 20 blocks. The quilt shown is only one way of arranging the blocks. Have fun arranging them in different layouts and then sew them with 4 blocks across and 5 blocks wide.

Add the border on all sides. Your top is finished! Layer your quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt no farther apart than 6". Sew on the label (you can machine-sew it to the backing before quilting). Bind the quilt, finishing it by hand or machine.
