

SHORT-CUT TRICK WITH A SNIP

This kit contains:

18 novelty print 6" squares

18 solid 6" squares

17 background 7-1/2" squares

Backing fabric

- Pair up a novelty square and a solid square, placing them right-sides together.
- Draw lines diagonally across the solid square. Using a 1/4" seam, sew all the way around the square.
- Pinch the solid square at the X in the center, lift it up and cut a small slit. Cut on both diagonal lines of the solid square only. Do not cut through the stitching.
- Press each flap open. Trim the square to 7-1/2", if necessary.



Quilt Assembly: Alternate the novelty squares with background squares and lay them out 5 across and 7 down. Sew them together, using a 3/8" seam [Your edges are bias and the wider seams will help]. Sandwich your quilt top and backing fabric.

Quilt no farther apart than 6". Finish your quilt with binding. Sew on the label.
