

## COLOR BLOCKS QUILT - 34"x43"



This baby quilt contains 12 blocks of "I-Spy" novelty fabrics.  
To make the quilt, you will need:

- 12 5" blocks of novelty fabrics, each with a different picture of animals or familiar objects
- 12 2½" strips of solid color fabrics, at least 30" long
- 4 5" wide strips of border fabrics, about 40" long
- Backing fabric 40" wide by 50" long

For each block, select a different colored strip. Cut into:  
two 5" strips and two 9" strips

Sew the 5" strips to the top and bottom of the block. .

Sew the 9" strips to the sides of the block. Press the block.

Lay out the blocks with three across and four down Sew them together. Add the 5" borders to all sides.

Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Make sure your quilt is quilted no less than 6" apart. Baby quilts need to hold up to frequent washing. Add a binding. Sew on the label
